The above company is recognised by Emirates as an Approved Maintenance Organisation (AMO) for the purposes of providing maintenance support and to issue Certificates of Release to Service (CRS) under its approval, in respect of work carried out on aircraft, engines, engine modules, APU's and other components owned and/or operated by Emirates subject to the following conditions:

The extent of work authorised shall be in accordance with the approved scope of work for aircraft maintenance and capability list for engine, engine module, APU or component workscope. Work shall be defined in the agreement between Emirates and the organisation. Work shall be carried out in accordance with Emirates and/or manufacturers approved manuals and documents.


The organisation shall ensure that all certifying staff and support staff receive sufficient continuation training in each two year period and up-to-date knowledge of relevant technology, organisation procedures including and not limited to Emirates and regulatory requirements, Human Factors, Fuel Tank Safety Systems & EWIS, and are competent in communicating in the English language. A CRS may only be issued by appropriately authorised staff quoting their company issued personal authorised number prefixed by the AMO number. During audits, Emirates will review details of certifying staff who are authorised to certify maintenance work and be regularly updated on any changes to those details.

The organisation shall ensure that all certifying and non-certifying staff are familiar with the Emirates Group Safety Policy, which is detailed in EPM 03-37 and/or in the Emirates SMS CD provided, as applicable. Additionally, the organisation shall ensure that all staff assigned to work on Emirates aircraft, engines, engine modules, APUs or other products as detailed in this MOA, complete the introduction to the Emirates SMS, which has been supplied. The organisation shall keep a record of all staff who have completed the introduction to the Emirates SMS.

Emirates has an established audit program for the purpose of ensuring compliance to the necessary standards of the regulation. In order to comply with this requirement, Emirates Compliance Monitoring will carry out periodic audits of the organisation after prior consultation and agreement.

This Maintenance Organisation Authorisation (MOA) shall only remain valid whilst an agreement exists between the company and Emirates, and only if the GCAA/EASA/FAA AMO approval, as appropriate, continues to remain valid. (Issuance of a CRS on an Emirates aircraft, or issuance of an AW Form 1 for an engine, engine module or APU requires a valid GCAA AMO approval). It is the responsibility of the holder to ensure that their GCAA/EASA/FAA AMO Approval remains valid throughout the duration of this MOA. Should an AMO be suspended/revoked or not renewed, the company shall IMMEDIATELY inform Emirates Compliance Monitoring.

The organisation may be audited at any time by UAE GCAA.

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
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
